Tickets sales were higher than expected (we sold out of glow sticks at an alarming rate and will ensure we purchase far more next year!!). At this event we really struggled to get volunteers to help us run the event, this left us understaffed at both discos which we all felt uncomfortable about afterwards. If we are unable to get enough volunteers in the future we will reduce to one disco and hence reduce the number of tickets available. The event however was a success and the children all seemed to enjoy it, we raised a simply amazing £1127.44!!

We cannot thank enough all the wonderful parents and staff who came together to make the event a success. So much amazing work goes on behind the scenes. How do we spend the all funds that we raise?

You might be surprised to find out how much is funded by us! Amongst other things, this year the Friends have paid for:

- The Christmas Tree
- Books from Father Christmas
- Budget to refresh Nativity costumes
- Each class teacher given a budget to use for Children's rewards etc.
- 50th Celebration artwork We are proud to have supported the school with the artwork to celebrate 50 years of Banks Road Infants School.
- New bookcases for all the classrooms (as advised bySpeech, Language and Communication service.)
- Easter eggs
- Refreshed our Disco lights
- Funded the Y2 cosy corner
- New fun rugs/carpets for the reception classes for your little ones to sit on.
- Year 2 leavers trip we fund the ticket price so the parents only need to pay for transport.





Working with the school we have lots of plans for the next year too. Firstly we will look to invest in a new sound system for the hall to help with assemblies, shows and also to use at Friends events. We are also looking at new book cases and seating for the hall to make finding an choosing books easier and more fun and further fun ideas to enhance some of the outside space.

Examples of what we have funded in previous years:

- Forest School The Friends funded the building of the Forest school behind the Nursery. Not only did we pay for the mud kitchen, fire pit, kettle etc. We also purchased puddle suits for all year groups so that every child can enjoy the area no matter what the weather. It also means you as parents do not have to provide your child with a suit (or deal with a muddy uniform!!).
- The large interactive portable screen that is used in the hall and throughout the school.
- iPads in recent years we have bought the school 20 iPads so every class has an opportunity to use them
- We have bought a camera for every class.
- General support for anything the school might need to enhance the children's learning (from playground toys, egg incubators to seeds!)



We hope you agree your money goes a long way and the events we run provide fun social events for the children and adults alike.

We need your help!

- As they say, 'every little helps'. You can support us simply by attending the events we put on, baking or offering half an hour of your time at an event to sell drinks or sweets etc. We also often need help to set-up and clear away.
