IMPORTANT MESSAGES

Slip, Slop, Slap, Seek, Slide, Drink

We will be learning about sun protection and encouraging children to use sunscreen and wear hats and sunglasses when outside. Please send your child to school with a wide-brimmed hat and apply an all-day protection to your child in the morning before school. If your child requires an additional application of cream at lunchtime then you may provide a named tube of sun cream (please note that spray creams are not allowed). This will be kept in a basket and taken into the playground at lunchtimes. A Midday Supervisor will oversee your child to apply their own cream. Adults in school cannot apply cream to the children.

P.E. Kit

It is more likely that PE sessions for Year 1 & 2 children will take place outside as the weather improves. Please check your child's PE shoes to ensure that they still fit. You can bring pumps or trainers to leave at school for PE sessions.

Playground Supervision

We would like to remind parents that children are welcome onto the school playground with a parent/carer before the classroom doors open at 8.45am. Children must not come into school unaccompanied. Staff are not required to be on playground duty before school and our insurance does not cover us to have children on the premises any earlier than this time on school days. Children are still the responsibility of their parents/carers until the school day begins at 8.45am. Please do not allow your child/ren to play on any of the equipment and supervise them closely at all times.
