

We are determined to create an inclusive culture of learning where all children will be challenged in their thinking, to achieve to the best of their abilities and strive to become lifelong learners.


We will empower our children to become respected citizens to enable them to make valuable contributions locally, globally and to contribute to our world's sustainable future.

- Encourage our child to take care of his/her surrounding and others around him/her.
- Come to the school to discuss any problems concerning our child's welfare.
- Support my child in homework (Learning Logs) and other opportunities for home learning.
- Ensure that family holidays are not taken during term time.
- Support the school's uniform policy.
- Park considerately near school and support the 'Park and Stride' ethos.
- Promote safe and appropriate use of technology at home.

As a child, I will:

- Wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance.
- Do all my work at school and at home as well as I can.
- Be polite, friendly and helpful to others.
- Look after myself, the school equipment and building.
- Follow the internet rules, ensuring that I use technology appropriately.

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- Adhere to social distancing rules in and around • school and ensure these are followed by all staff and children
- Inform parents immediately if an adult or child in their child's class bubble display any covid-19 symptoms
- Ensure staff who display symptoms are tested for covid-19 and put 'test and trace' measure in place for their bubble group.
- Ensure all staff follow good hand and respiratory hygiene
- Ensure children stay in their class bubble and that contact with other adults is minimised
- Regularly clean/disinfect surfaces that are ٠ regularly touched
- Wear PPE when in close contact with a child • through illness/injury
- Manage confirmed cases of covid-19 within the school community
- Contain any outbreak by following local health protection team advice
- Only use public transport if absolutely necessary and ensure I socially distance and wear a face covering if I do.

- Adhere to social distancing rules when on school premises

- Ensure my child does not bring things into school • from home
- Only use public transport to school if absolutely . necessary and ensure my child and I are socially distanced and wear a face covering if we do

- Adhere to social distancing rules in my class, outdoor play areas, and when I am waiting to enter school
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell •
- Not bring in things from home, or take things home from school
- Only use equipment provided to me by school
- Not mix with any other children • outside my bubble group
- Only enter and exit the school building • by my classroom door
- Follow good respiratory hygiene • 'catch it, bin it, kill it'
- Follow good hand hygiene rules ٠ wash my hands for 20 seconds using soap and water
- Behave well at all times to ensure the safety of myself and others
