






### Life Cycle of an Oak Tree Answers


Children will have drawn their own pictures and written their own explanation, for example:




An acorn falls from an oak tree.



The acorn starts to shoot and a seedling grows.



After many years, the sapling grows into a full-sized oak tree. It produces its own acorns. The cycle begins again.



The seedling grows into a sapling (a young tree).
