#### **Holiday Club Spaces**

#### **Transition Day**

#### Sun Safe Policy

As the weather is starting to improve please can we remind parents about our Sun Safe policy? We ask that you apply a once per day sun cream to your children before school and provide and hat (and sunglasses if required) for outdoor play times. We will be reminding children of the need to 'slip, slop, slide, shade, drink'! You may provide a **named** tube of sun cream for your child to keep in school, this will be kept in a basket in the class room for the child to apply as required during the day. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school. Thank you for your support in this matter.
