Phase 5 Secret Word Phonics Game

Teacher Guidance

Cut out each grid and children can either write (or insert the magnetic letter/ letters of) the sound for each picture to make a secret word.

NB all pictures represent the initial sound except the <u>underlined</u> pictures which represent the Phase 5 digraphs. E.g. ele<u>ph</u>ant represents /ph/ not /e/, crayon represents /ay/ not /c/. Those picture clues with an asterisk * represent a split digraph.

This game includes sounds from Phase 2, 3 and 5. Both phonemes in the phase 4 consonant blends and clusters are represented by separate pictures e.g. 'st' is represented by $\underline{\mathbf{s}}$ ocks and $\underline{\mathbf{t}}$ omato rather than a $\underline{\mathbf{s}}$ tarfish.
